



## **Proud Stratford Support Group Volunteer Role Description**

Volunteering with Warwickshire Pride is an incredibly rewarding experience that will enable you to make a difference to the lives of LGBT+ people, as well as developing your skills. We are currently seeking volunteers to join our team and help to run the Proud Stratford support group. The group takes place monthly and is for LGBT+ people living in Stratford-upon-Avon and the surrounding areas. The group provides a safe, welcoming, inclusive space where LGBT+ people can be themselves, meet new people, socialise and access support if they need to.

The Proud Stratford support group runs on:

The second Saturday of each month from 11:00am – 1:00pm at Foundation House in Stratford-upon-Avon.

As a Warwickshire Pride volunteer, you will be entitled to paid expenses, as much tea, coffee and cake as you can handle, various training opportunities, and access to our Proud Volunteers closed Facebook page. Regular social events are also held for Warwickshire Pride volunteers.

### **The Role**

The purpose of this role is to:

Facilitate the Proud Stratford support group where LGBT+ people can be themselves, meet new people, socialise and access support.

Main duties include:

- Providing advice, guidance and support to attendees;
- Facilitating discussions with attendees;
- Liaising with Warwickshire Pride management about how the group is going.

Key qualities required:

- Friendly;
- Reliable;
- Trustworthy;
- Open-minded;

- Approachable;
- Able to remain calm and diplomatic in challenging situations.

Please note that experience is not required for this role, as we will provide an induction and ongoing training. However, you must have all the key qualities listed above.
